

Guidelines for Video Virtual Presentation

Dear Researchers, for all of you who are planning to participate in the conference via a Video Virtual Presentation, here is a list of useful guidelines.

Once your proposal has been accepted, you will be invited to register for the conference as a virtual presenter. Upon payment of the registration fee, your paper will be included in the conference proceedings and it will be listed as a virtual presentation.

All Virtual Presenters are asked to follow the following guidelines.

You should prepare a 10 minutes video presentation, having you presenting in front of a camera or your voice over the PowerPoint or a combination of any other creative methods of presentation. You may use multiple screens, one for the PowerPoint presentation and a smaller one including you as the presenter (i.e., Figure 1).

- This video should not be more than 10 minutes in length
- The resolution of the video should be of high definition (720p or 1080p)
- Upload your video file on YouTube and send your 1) video link and 2) presentation slides to the following e-mail addresses: conference@iabl.org and tsinakos@teiemt.gr, with the Subject: **WCBL2019 virtual presentation – YOUR LAST NAME**
- All of your presentations will be also included in the IABL YouTube channel
